I SCHEDULE OF ADMISSIONS

As per DASA-2019 guidelines, the dates for reporting by candidates who have been allotted seat in Rounds 1, 2, 3, and 4 to allotted Institutes are **21- 26 July 2019**.

According to the present schedule, admission of candidates admitted under JoSAA (JEE Main 2019) overlaps with this schedule. Moreover, academic session for the First Year students is scheduled to commence from **24th July 2019**. Hence, for the sake of convenience, a branch-wise Admission Schedule has been proposed. The **Originals** of the following documents have to be brought at the time of reporting for admission:

2. Provisional allotment letter.
3. 10th standard / Matriculation or equivalent certificate or any other certificate issued by government authorities, as proof of date of birth.
4. Mark sheet/grade card and Pass certificate of the qualifying examination.
5. Certificate from the school studied as proof of completion of 11th and 12th **in case of candidates whose final results are awaited** (as per the format in Appendix II of DASA Information Brochure- 2019).
6. SAT Score Card issued by College Board
7. School Leaving / Transfer Certificate from the Institution last attended.
8. Character and Conduct Certificate from the Institution last attended.
9. Character and Conduct Certificate from a Gazetted Officer issued after January 31, 2019 for candidates who have passed the qualifying examination in years prior to the academic year 2018-2019.
10. Passport and VISA to prove the eligibility of DASA candidature.
11. For candidates who are Indian citizens, certificates proving that he/she completed 11th and 12th from an institution abroad (as per Appendix IV of DASA Information Brochure- 2019), if it is not clear from the School Leaving / Transfer Certificate
12. For CIWG category of candidates, the proof that either of the parent is working in gulf country will be: (1) Passport of the parent working in the gulf, (2) Parent's visa (3) Parent's Work Permit (If any), and (4) Certificate from the company/organization as proof that parent is working in gulf country as per Appendix III of DASA Information Brochure- 2019
13. Medical Certificate issued by a Govt. Medical Officer not below the rank of Asst. Surgeon in the prescribed format. The format shall be available in the link:

14. Passport size photographs –5
15. Stamp size photographs -2
16. Copy of the first page of savings bank (SB) account passbook in the name of candidate held in the State Bank of India (*candidates who do not have an SBI account can utilize the service of the 'special SBI counter' functioning at the admission venue during the admission days*)
17. Statement/Receipt of Institute fee payment (Section III (ii)below)
18. Statement/Receipt of payment of deficit amount, if applicable (Section III (i)below)
19. One copy each of the above certificates (item 3 to 12), self-attested.

Note: If any certificate is in a language other than English/Hindi, an English version of that certificate attested by a Gazetted Officer / Competent Authority should be produced compulsorily.

Candidate must be present in person along with parent / authorized guardian for taking admission at NITC. (The authorized guardian should possess a photo ID Card and authorization letter from the parent). Admission in absentia (proxy) will not be allowed even on medical grounds. If the candidate does not report on the above mentioned date and time, his/her admission is liable to be cancelled.

(iii) Hostel Fee

(a) Fee at the time of admission (All candidates)-**Rs.15, 000/-**

(b) HOSTEL AND MESS MONTHLYCHARGES

- Hostel room rent, electricity charge, water charge, mess and other establishment charges are payable on monthly basis.
- Hostel charges including rent, water charge, electricity charge, etc. will be approximately Rs.1000/- per month.
- Mess charges will be based on the type of mess and the quantity of extra food items consumed by the student and will be approximately 3,500/-per month.

However, parents/students can pay an amount of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only) at the beginning of every semester as an advance against both hostel and mess charges. If found less, parents/students will be informed to pay the balance. If found excess, balance amount will be carried over to the next semester.
