### 1. Reporting

### 2. Documents to be brought by the candidate at the time of admission

The **Originals** of the following documents have to be brought and submitted at the time of reporting for admission:

1. Provisional allotment letter.
2. 10<sup>th</sup> standard / Matriculation or equivalent certificate or any other certificate issued by government authorities, as proof for date of birth.
3. Mark sheet/grade card and Pass certificate of the qualifying examination.
4. Certificate from the school studied as proof of completion of 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> **in case of candidates whose final results are awaited** (as per the format in Appendix II of DASA information Brochure.
5. School Leaving / Transfer Certificate from the Institution last attended.
6. Character and Conduct Certificate from the Institution last attended.
7. Character and Conduct Certificate from a Gazetted Officer issued after January 31, 2017 for candidates who have passed the qualifying examination in years prior to the academic year 2016-2017.
8. Passport and VISA to prove the eligibility of DASA candidature.
9. Certificates proving that the candidate completed 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> from an institution abroad (as per Appendix IV of DASA Admission Brochure) if it is not clear from the School Leaving / Transfer Certificate
10. For CIWG category of candidates, the proof that either of the parent is working in gulf country will be: (1) Copy of the passport of the parent working in the gulf, (2) Copy of Parent's visa , (3) Copy of Parent's Work Permit (If any), (4) Certificate from the company/organization as proof that parent is working in gulf country as per Appendix III of DASA UG Brochure
11. Physical Fitness Certificate issued by a Govt. Medical Officer not below the rank of Asst. Surgeon in the prescribed format. The format shall be available in the link:

Candidates are advised to keep sufficient number of copies of mark lists and other certificates for their future use, if any, since all the original certificates submitted to NIT Calicut at the time of admission will be retained in the Institute till the completion of the admission process.

If any certificate is in a language other than English, an English version of that certificate attested by a Gazetted Officer / Competent Authority should be produced compulsorily.

Candidate must be present in person along with parent / authorised guardian for taking admission at NITC. (The authorized guardian should possess the authorization letter with photo identity from the parent). Admission in absentia (proxy) will not be allowed even on medical grounds. If the candidate does not report on the above mentioned date and time, his/her admission is likely to be cancelled.

#### **(iii) Hostel Fee**

**(a) Fee at the time of admission (All candidates)-Rs. 15,000/-.**

**(b) HOSTEL AND MESS MONTHLY CHARGES**

Hostel room rent, electricity charge, water charge, mess and other establishment charges are payable on monthly basis.

- Hostel charges including rent, water charge, electricity charge, etc. will be approximately Rs.1000/- per month.
- Mess charges will be based on the type of mess and the quantity of extra food items consumed by the student and will be approximately 3,500/-per month.

However, parents/students can pay an amount of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only) at the beginning of every semester as an advance against both hostel and mess charges. If found less, parents/students will be informed to pay the balance. If found excess, balance amount will be carried over to the next semester.
