DASA/CIWG SCHEME - 2022 (SPOT ROUND)

I. SCHEDULE OF PHYSICAL REPORTING FOR INSTITUTE ADMISSION

Physical reporting for institute admission for candidates, whose who have been allotted seat in spot round at NIT Calicut under DASA/CIWG scheme,, is scheduled from **28-11-2022 (Monday) to 29-11-2022 (Tuesday)**, timing is from 9.00 am to 5.00 pm.

Accordingly, Candidates and their parents are requested to follow the instructions and procedures given below. **Failing to report physically for institute admission on or before 29th November 2022, 5.00 pm will result in the cancellation of the allotted seat.**

Candidates are required to report at UG admission office, NIT Calicut with all original of documents (as applicable), given in Section II. The candidates who are allotted seat at NIT Calicut under DASA/CIWG scheme in DASA/CIWG Spot round need to note about following online process, which need to completed prior to physical reporting.

Online Process:

Candidate, will receive an email from the institute to registered Email ID (in DASA 2022) . The Email will be having the details of Institute Management System (IMS) portal URL along with NITC institute email ID and temporary password (institute Roll Number).

NITC institute email ID and temporary password can be used to login in the portal for online Data Entry and uploading documents (as instructed in portal), Institute fee online payment (as applicable as per information given in Section III) within the portal.

Candidates should check the spam folder of their registered Email ID, in case they do not receive the email in the Inbox.

Candidates are required to login in the IMS portal using NITC institute email ID and temporary password (Institute roll number) and then proceed to online Data Entry, uploading signature, photo and documents, as instructed given in portal.

NITC institute email ID work same way as gmail and it also works at google email platform. Institute roll number act as its temporary password. To safeguard the data in email, one may change password as done in gmail. IMS portal can be access at any time using NITC institute email ID and its password

Further all communications will be happening via Portal and/or institute email ID. Candidates are advised to complete the online process including Institute balance fee payment, one day prior the physical reporting.

After the login to IMS portal, candidates are required to select to whether hostel accommodation is required or not, if yes, complete the payment as shown in the above notice and enter SBI collect reference number (DU number), transaction date and amount in the IMS portal.

II. DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCE AT THE TIME OF INSTITUTE ADMISSION

Following is the list of documents, which has to be produced before **5:00 pm, 29th November 2022 Monday**)

1. Relevant Pages of Candidate's passport and VISA in a single PDF file (Nationals of Nepal who do not have a passport, copy of Authenticated Citizenship Card needed to be submitted) or PIO/OCI card as applicable
2. 10th standard/Matriculation or equivalent certificate or any other certificate issued by government authorities, as proof of date of birth and Name of Candidate).
3. Mark sheet/grade card and Pass certificate (**if issued separately from school**) of the qualifying examination.
4. Certificate from the school studied as proof of completion of 11th and 12th **in case of candidates whose final results are awaited** (as per the format in **Appendix II** of DASA Information Brochure- 2022).
5. JEE 2022 Score Card issued by NTA.
6. School Leaving / Transfer Certificate from the Institution last attended.
7. Character and Conduct Certificate from the Institution last attended, for candidates who have passed the qualifying examination in current academic year 2021-2022.

Or Character and Conduct Certificate from a Gazetted Officer, issued after 1st July, 2022, for candidates, who have passed the qualifying examination in years prior to the academic year 2021-2022.

8. Proof the Institute fee payment as applicable as per details given in the Section III as this information sheet,
9. For candidates who are Indian citizens, certificates proving that he/she completed 11th and 12th from an institution abroad (as per **Appendix IV** of DASA Information Brochure- 2022), if it is not clear from the School Leaving / Transfer Certificate
10. Candidates, whose eligible category includes CIWG, the proof that either of the parent is working in gulf country will be:

(1) Passport of the parent working in the gulf, (2) Parent's visa (3) Parent's Work Permit (If any), and (4) Certificate from the company/organization as proof that parent is working in gulf countries as per **Appendix III** of DASA Information Brochure- 2022.

Note: 1. If the parent not able to travel with candidate, attested (by a Gazetted officer) copy of relevant pages of the parent's passport and parent's visa can be submitted at time of physical reporting.

11. Medical Certificate issued by a Registered medical practitioner in the prescribed format. The format is available in the link:

 - 12 years General Secondary Education Certificate of the Ministry of Education Bahrain, Egypt, Jordan, Kuwait, Oman, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates and other Gulf countries.
 - GCE/ IGCSE/ GCSE examinations of the approved British Examination Bodies, with Minimum 5(Five) subjects in A, B, C Grades including English at ORDINARY ('O') Level and 2/3 subjects at ADVANCED LEVEL has been equated with +2 stage qualification. Candidates intending to join Professional courses are required to have passed the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, and Biology/Mathematics in ADVANCED LEVEL & English at AS LEVEL.
 - 12-year High School Diploma from accredited Schools of USA.
 - Intermediate/Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary examinations of the approved Boards in Pakistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan and Nepal.
 - 12-year Secondary Stage qualification of National Examinations Board of the Ministry of Education, Ethiopia, Sudan.

- ii)** Declarations and Undertakings (Sl. No 13 to 16 and 18) are to be printed in plain A4 papers and signed by the parent and candidate as specified.
- iii)** Self attested copy of documents mentioned in serial number 2, 3, 4 and 12. If seat category is CIWG, self attested copy of parent's passport and visa, in case the parent is present with candidate at time of physical reporting.
