NOTICE

Rules regarding Election Campaign


1. No PA system should be used for campaigning.
2. The candidate shall not provide any form of transport to the voters.
3. All campaign materials including pamphlets, posters and banners are to be approved by the Returning Officer.
4. Students should desist from disfiguring the class rooms, hostels, compound walls, roads and buildings in the institute campus by pasting of posters or writing on the walls or roads as part of their election campaign. They should also desist from disfiguring the compound walls of neighbouring buildings as well.
5. Election campaign/propaganda in the institute campus should be limited to the issue of pamphlets and bit-notice, display of banners and posters and conducting group meetings to present the candidates.
6. Persons who are not on the rolls of the institute should not be allowed to take part in the campaign work in the institute campus.
7. Students should not arrange election campaign meetings in the institute campus during working hours except with the specific sanction of the Director.
8. The campaigning shall end 24 hours before commencement of the election.
9. There should not be any sort of canvassing/propaganda in the institute campus on the day fixed for the poll till the election results are announced.
10. Any kind of indiscipline from the students' side during the election process will not be tolerated and stern disciplinary action will be initiated against such students.

Display of Banners

Display of banners and notices are permitted under the condition that the following rules will be **strictly adhered to**.

- 11. The size of the banner shall not exceed 3 feet in width and 6 feet in length.**
- 12. Each panel of candidates shall erect a maximum of 5 banners. Individual banners from candidates are not permitted.**
13. The banners should not carry any offensive references to other candidates or to the administration.
14. No banners are permitted inside any buildings or porches.

15. Upon notification the banners will be taken down immediately, and without any reservations.
16. Banner display is **completely forbidden** in the area **painted in red** the map below. **It is also forbidden to erect banners in front of the main gate.**
17. No banners are permitted within 30 Meter radius from the entry of any polling stations.
18. All materials used for campaign should be made of bio-degradable materials. **Banners, posters or pamphlets that are made of plastic/flex are not permitted.** The candidate will be responsible for safe disposal of the campaign material after the election.
19. Banners (if any) should be approved by the undersigned **before displaying them** anywhere on the campus.



20. Banners shall not be erected across any of the main gates, including those of the East campus and those leading to the residential areas of the campus.

A candidate's candidature will be cancelled if the candidate or his/her approved nominee is found violating any of the above rules.
