NOTICE

Rules regarding stoppage of Election Campaign

1. Public campaigning by candidates / his nominees shall be stopped at **12:00 noon on 13/9/17 (Wednesday)**.
2. **Addressing groups of students (more than two in number) on the institute roads/ premises and erecting new banners/posters/circulating printed notices shall constitute Public Campaign for the purpose of Rule-1 above.**
3. **ANY FORM of campaign by nominees/representatives of the candidates shall constitute Public Campaign for the purpose of Rule-1 above.**
4. Addressing a **gathering of students in common rooms / open spaces inside the Hostels/within institute premises** shall also constitute Public Campaign for the purpose of Rule-1 above.
5. The candidate, **personally**, is allowed to do a door to door campaign on 13/09/17. But all such campaigning shall end by 6 p.m. on 13/09/17. **Door to door campaign is not allowed in the First Year Men's Hostels.**
6. Candidates are allowed to do *online* campaign, such as through Facebook *etc.*, on 13/09/17 but all such campaigning shall stop by 8 pm on 13/09/17.
7. No form of campaigning/canvassing/propaganda is allowed on the institute campus on the day fixed for the polls.
8. Any kind of indiscipline from the students' side during the election process will not be tolerated and stern disciplinary action will be initiated against such students.
9. **All Banners/Notices displayed by the candidates as part of their Election Campaign should be removed by 5 p.m. on 15/09/2017. Littering of campus should be avoided at all costs.**

A candidate's candidature will be cancelled if the candidate or his/her approved nominee is found violating any of the above rules.
