### NIT Calicut announces SILA Scholarships for Civil Engineering Students

The **SILA** scholarships for B.Tech. students of Department of Civil Engineering, National Institute of Technology Calicut, for the academic year 2022-2023 are announced. Ms. Sreelekshmi S. (Third semester: CGPA 9.06), **Ms. A. Anjana** (Fifth semester: CGPA 9.85), and **Ms. Kanyaparvathi S.** (Seventh semester: CGPA 9.5) will receive Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) each, for securing the top CGPA at the end of their first, second and third year of study of the B.Tech Civil Engineering degree programme. Mr. **Rajdip Das** (Third semester: CGPA 8.94) and **Mr. Gompa Naveen** (Fifth semester: CGPA 9.39), will receive Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty thousand only) each, for securing the second highest CGPA at the end of their first, and second year of study, while **Mr. R. Harikrishnan** (Seventh semester: CGPA 9.23) and **Mr. S. Vishnuprasadha** (Seventh semester: 9.23) will receive Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each, for jointly securing the second highest CGPA at the end of their third year of study of the B.Tech Civil Engineering degree programme.

The SILA scholarship was instituted by a distinguished alumnus of CREC 1967 – 1972 B.Sc. Civil Engineering programme, **Shri. Sivaramakrishnan S. Iyer**, for students of the Department of Civil Engineering, NIT Calicut. The SILA scholarship was instituted in the memory of his parents, **Subramonia Iyer** and **Lekshmi Ammal**. An amount of Rs. 40,00,000/- (Rupees Forty lakh only) was donated to CREC SJET (CREC Silver Jubilee Endowment Trust), the interest from which is being utilised for the disbursement of scholarships. For the year 2022-2023, the total scholarship amount is Rs. 2,10,000/- (Rupees Two lakhs and Ten thousand only). The scholarship amount, along with citation, would be disbursed to the student with the highest score and second highest score, based on his / her performance in the first,

second and third year of study. Students with the highest score are awarded an amount of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty thousand only) and those with the second highest score are awarded Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty thousand only), in an academic year. In case of a tie, the amount is split equally among the students, as in the present case.


