

Admission Process for NITs through AIEEE 2009 commenced on 8th June 2009

The Off- campus On-line registration , choice filling and locking for admission to B.Tech / B. Arch programmes for the year 2009 for admitting students to 20 NITs and other institutes admitting students through AIEEE 2009 commenced on June 8, 2009. The admission to all the twenty NITs are based on the Central Counselling of AIEEE 2009 amongst the candidates declared “Permitted to fill up choices on-line for counselling” on the basis of AIEEE 2009 conducted by CBSE. The candidates can register on-line through internet (www.ccb.nic.in) from a place of their convenience. **Arrangements are also made at NIT Calicut for guidance where they can do their registration, choice filling and locking during working hours (Monday to Friday).**

The detailed procedure for the on-line registration is as described: A candidate has to open the website www.ccb.nic.in and click on “**Online Registration, Choice Filling and Locking**”. Register as a new candidate by clicking on “**New user Registration!! here**” link. Select the stream (Engineering/Architecture). Read the instructions given on the screen. The candidate will register online by entering the following as indicated in the Admit card: Name, Roll number, Application number and Date of Birth. This data submitted by the candidate will be verified with the AIEEE – 2009 data base of CBSE and if it matches then only the candidate will be permitted to proceed further and the candidate is required to give his own password. (for more details refer information brochure of AIEEE2009). Next time, the candidate can login directly with Roll number as login ID and the chosen password as Password. Whenever the candidates login, they have to LOGOUT at the end. Candidates are advised to record/remember their password for all future Logins.

After login, the personal data of the candidate will automatically appear on the screen as per AIEEE-2009 data base. The candidate must verify his/her personal data. If there is any discrepancy, the candidate will be allowed **only once** to change his/her personal data of category, sub-category, etc. Candidate can take a printout of the registration form with the above personal data. ***If the personal data verified and submitted by the candidate is found to be wrong at the time of verification of certificates during remote reporting or at a later stage, the provisional allotment of seat by CCB is liable to be cancelled.*** It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to verify his/her personal data, including category, subcategory, state of eligibility and gender as per documentary evidence. **By changing the category, sub category, state of eligibility and gender, eligibility of the candidate may change.**

The registered candidates can exercise their choices of the branches and institutions in the order of preference of the candidate. The procedure for exercising choices and seeking pertinent information is guided through appropriate messages and tabs on the computer screen. As per the eligibility of the candidate, available seat information relating to institutions, disciplines (Engineering / Technology and Architecture / Planning), branches (e.g., Electronics Engineering, Computer Science, etc.) will be displayed. The candidate can give as many numbers of choices in the order of preference as he/she wishes from the list of available seats. . The candidates are permitted, if they so desire, to change or re-order their choices, delete earlier choices and add new choices any number of times until they lock their choices on or before June 28, 2009 by 11.55PM.

Based on the number of registered candidates who have submitted their choices at that time, indicative seat allotment will be shown. This indicative seat allotment (Mock counselling) will facilitate the selection of the most appropriate discipline, institution and branch at the candidate’s rank, state of eligibility and in their categories for finalization of their choices for locking. The indicative seat allotment will be done during June 08, 2009 to June 24, 2009 and will be put on the web at frequent intervals. The dates of update of indicative seat allocation will be displayed on the website during this

period. All the candidates are strongly advised to register and fill their choices during June 08, 2009 to June 24, 2009 to know the indicative seat allotment.

After filling the choices in the order of preference, the candidate **must lock** his/her choices. Without locking, the choices will not be processed for seat allotment. Hence, all the candidates **MUST** lock their choices on or before June 28, 2009 by 11.55PM. However, candidates are advised to lock their choices well in advance instead of waiting till the dead line. ***If a candidate fails to lock his / her choices on or before June 28, 2009 by 11.55 PM, the choices filled by the candidate will not be considered for seat allotment, and the candidate shall forego his / her right for consideration of his/her candidature for seat allotment.*** After locking of the choices, the candidates cannot change their choices under any circumstances. After locking of the choices, a printable version of the choices is displayed. A print-out of these locked choices is to be preserved by the candidate for future reference. After locking the choices, if a candidate logs in again, then the locked choices given by the candidate only will be displayed. The seat allotment in any of the rounds will be only from the locked in choices by the candidate on or before 28th June 2009.

Remote Reporting: The candidates who get seat allotment have to report at any one of the admission centres of CCB for taking provisional admission with the required documents proving their eligibility and demand drafts. In Kerala, National Institute of Technology Calicut (NIT Calicut) is the Admission Centre of CCB, MHRD. The documents to be produced at the time of remote reporting are Admit Card of AIEEE2009, Score Card of AIEEE2009, 10th class certificate (as proof of age), Certificate of 10+2 (with Mark list and Pass Certificate), certificate proving category (for SC/ST and OBC) in the prescribed format specified by CCB, MHRD (as given in the annexure I and II of the information brochure of AIEEE2009, CCB), Subcategory certificate (in the case of physically handicapped candidates, as given in the annexure III of the information brochure of AIEEE2009, CCB), Passport (in case of candidates who have studied abroad, as proof of state of eligibility), Transfer certificate (in case if the candidates do not possess a valid document as proof of their place of study for 10+2).Candidates have to submit two demand drafts, both drawn in favour of **Chairman CCB-2009** and payable at **Warangal**. One demand draft is to be taken for an amount of **Rs.24, 000/-** and another for an amount of **Rs.1000/-**. Those candidates who have been allotted a seat and who do not report to the Admission Centre on the specified dates will lose their claim for the seat. The CCB admission schedule is as given below:

10	Reporting at Allotted institute	July 16 to 24, 2009

Physical Reporting at Allotted Institute: The candidates have to report physically at their allotted institutes with the necessary documents (as specified by the respective institutes) between 16th July and 24th July 2009, as per the admission schedule. Failing which the candidate will lose the provisional admission offered to him by CCB.

Candidates are advised to read the information brochure and other details pertaining to admission process, given in the website www.ccb.nic.in before proceeding to the registration, choice filling and locking.
